WHEREAS, operation status and alarms are communicated via Northern Data Systems, Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition ("SCADA") and the Authority has determined that five (5) of the pump stations require upgrades to be completed on an emergency basis in order to maintain continuous communications; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 and N.J.A.C. 5:34-6.1, any contract may be negotiated or awarded for a contracting unit without public advertising for bids and bidding therefor, notwithstanding that the contract price will exceed the bid threshold, when an emergency affecting the public health, safety, or welfare requires the immediate delivery of goods or the performance of services; and

WHEREAS, Authority Engineer Dennis K. Yoder, P.E., P.P., C.M.E., submitted correspondence dated October 18, 2021, which outlines and supports the upgrades to be performed on an emergency basis; and

WHEREAS. Northern Data Systems has confirmed that they have the ability to commence the emergency work required as soon as a contract is executed with the Authority in an amount not to exceed \$44,160.00.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, upon proper motion and vote at a public meeting by the Washington Township Municipal Utilities Authority in the County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. The Authority hereby authorizes award of an emergency contract pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A-11-6 to Northern Data Systems for emergency repairs/upgrades to five (5) pump stations for operation status and alarms in an amount not to exceed \$44,160.00. Said contract shall be limited to duration as to meet only the immediate needs of this emergency.
- 2. The Executive Director or Superintendent are therefore authorized to execute a written agreement with Northern Data Systems in a form approved by the Solicitor and consistent with their submission.
- 3. The Executive Director or Superintendent are authorized to execute other documents as necessary to facilitate and complete the Contract.
- 4. The Contract Award is contingent on the Authority's Chief Financial Officer's Certification that there exist sufficient appropriated funds for the Contract.
- 5. The Authority shall publish a brief notice stating the nature, duration, service, and amount of the Contract, and that the Resolution and Contract are on file and available for public inspection in the office of the Authority.
