- 4. The contract is further contingent on Account Data Services, Inc. submitting a sworn statement that, during one-year period preceding the Agreement, it has not

made a contribution that is reportable by the recipient under <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 19:44A-1, et seq., to any municipal committee of a political party in that municipality if a member of that political party is serving in an elective public office of that municipality when the contract is awarded or to any candidate committee of any person serving in an elective public office of that municipality when the contract is awarded. The Certification shall also state that the entity shall refrain from making such a contribution during the term of the contract.

- 5. The contract is contingent on the Authority's Chief Financial Officers prior certification that there exists funds for which to pay for this contract. The applicable line-item appropriation(s) in the Authority's official budget is/are as follows: 01-01-100-603 and 01-02-100-603. The Certification of Availability of Funds shall be attached to the original copy of this Resolution.
- 6. The Authority shall publish once, in the official newspaper, a brief notice stating the nature, duration, service, and amount of the contract, and that the Resolution and contract are on file and available for public inspection in the office of the Authority.
- 7. The Authority's Officers and Professionals are authorized to execute other documents necessary to achieve the purposes of this Resolution.
