RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITY AUTHORITY DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO REIMBURSE ITSELF FROM THE PROCEEDS OF ONE OR MORE TAX-EXEMPT BOND OBLIGATIONS FOR CERTAIN EXPENDITURES TO BE MADE IN CONNECTION WITH THE SCHEDULED IMPROVEMENTS TO THE AUTHORITY'S SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Washington Township Municipal Utilities Authority (the "Authority"), in the Township of Washington, County of Gloucester is a political subdivision organized and existing under the laws of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Authority intends to finance, on and after the date hereof, certain expenditures (the "Expenditures") in connection with scheduled improvements to the Authority's public water and sewer systems, including but not limited to repainting of the Authority's water tanks and replacement of a deteriorated section of sewer main, and each including design and engineering services, and which are eligible for capital financing under the Internal Revenue Code (the "Project"), with tax-exempt bonds of the Authority expected to be issued through a public or private sale; and

WHEREAS, the Authority reasonably anticipates that obligations, the interest on which is excluded from gross income under Section 103 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), will be issued by the Authority directly to finance the Project on a long-term basis in an amount not to exceed \$6,500,000 (the "Tax Exempt Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, the Authority desires to preserve its right to treat an allocation of proceeds of the Tax Exempt Bonds to the reimbursement of Expenditures paid prior to the issuance of the Tax Exempt Bonds as an expenditure for such Expenditures to be reimbursed for purposes of Sections 103 and 141 through 150, inclusive, of the Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Board hereby declares the Authority's intent to reimburse the Authority with the proceeds of the Tax Exempt Bonds for the Expenditures with respect to the Project made on and after the date hereof. The Authority reasonably expects on the date hereof that it will reimburse the Expenditures with the proceeds of the Tax Exempt Bonds.

Section 2. Each Expenditure will be (a) of a type properly chargeable to capital account under general federal income tax principles (determined in each case as of the date of the Expenditure) and (b) complies with the laws of the State of New Jersey.

Section 3. The maximum cost of the Project is expected not to exceed \$6,500,000.

Section 4. The Board authorizes and directs the Executive Director to designate the "original expenditures" in a written reimbursement allocation, which is a written allocation by the Authority that evidences the Authority's use of proceeds of the Tax Exempt Bonds to reimburse an Expenditure, no later than eighteen (18) months after the later of the date on which the Expenditure is paid or the Project is placed in service or abandoned, but in no event more than three (3) years after the date on which the Expenditure is paid. The Authority recognizes that exceptions are available for certain "preliminary expenditures," costs of issuance, certain *de minimis* amounts, expenditures by "small issuers" (based on the year of issuance and not the year of expenditure) and expenditures for construction projects of at least five (5) years.

Section 5. All resolutions, or parts thereof, inconsistent herewith are hereby rescinded and repealed to the extent of any such inconsistency.

Section 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption this 30th day of October, 2023.
