



Replacement of the existing water main, gravity sewer main, and force main including all appurtenances located within the public right of way on Whitman Drive located in Washington Township, Gloucester County, New Jersey in the amount of 2,660,264.00. The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (NJIB) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States. Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the NJIB to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects. This project will provide water quality benefits, by replacing the existing asbestos concrete pipe with ductile iron piping to reduce the risk of main breaks and contamination. The project will also replace exiting clay pipe that is prone to the intrusion of tree roots, and will also reduce the risk of potential future leaks to the surrounding environment. State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
