WHEREAS, the Authority has determined that it is necessary and appropriate to update its Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual to reflect current legal requirements, best practices, and the operational needs of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the updated Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, has been prepared with due consideration of applicable laws, regulations, and best practices in public sector human resources management; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's legal counsel has reviewed the updated Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual and has determined that it complies with all applicable laws and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Board of Commissioners has reviewed the updated Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual and believes that it will (1) provide clear guidance to Authority

5. The Executive Director, or his/her designee, is hereby authorized and directed to provide a copy of the updated Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual to all new employees upon hire and to require each new employee to acknowledge receipt and review of the Manual in writing as a condition of employment.
6. The Executive Director, or his/her designee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement and enforce the policies and procedures set forth in the updated Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual.

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7. The Authority reserves the right to modify, revise, supplement, or rescind any policies or portion of the Manual from time to time as it deems necessary or appropriate, in its sole and absolute discretion, consistent with applicable law and regulations.
8. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this Resolution shall be deemed valid and effective.
9. All resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
10. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption according to law.

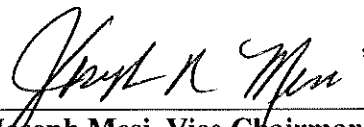
1. The Municipal Utilities Authority hereby moves Matthew Esposito from Repairman I to Repairman II with a starting date of July 20, 2026.

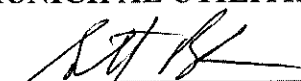

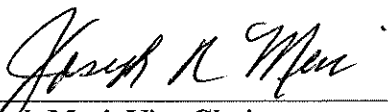

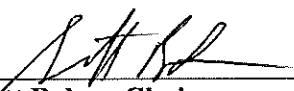
